Experience cultural and spiritual visits, the **Chiwong Chhyang-Chup Monastery**, established in the early 1920s, where they can enjoy a simple lunch with monks and participate in a meditation session in a serene prayer hall. Another noteworthy visit is the **Thupten Choeling Monastery**, one of the most significant sites for Tibetan Buddhism outside of Tibet. Walk through Junbesi, known as the cradle of Sherpa culture, and Chyalsa, once a major center for Tibetan arts and handcrafted carpets. A highlight of the trip is a hike to **Ratnange Ridge** (10,500 ft), where guests can spend the night in expedition-style tents. This experience includes watching the sunset and sunrise over the Eastern Himalayas, with stunning views of **Mt. Everest**. The Happy House offers only 10 en-suites, with features including a yoga and meditation house and a candle-lit massage room for spa treatments. Guests can relax in the pine-shaded garden, read, or unwind by a roaring fire during their leisure time. Meals are customized by a dedicated team of over 40 people and are served in various private settings around the property.

Delve into the rich history of **Drugyel Dzong**, an ancient fortress constructed to guard the picturesque Paro Valley, and visit **Simtokha Dzong**, Bhutan's oldest fortress, which also serves as a distinguished center for Buddhist learning. Finally, bask in the breathtaking beauty of **Dochula Monastery**, surrounded by the 108 chortens, each a timeless tribute to the King's extraordinary leadership.
